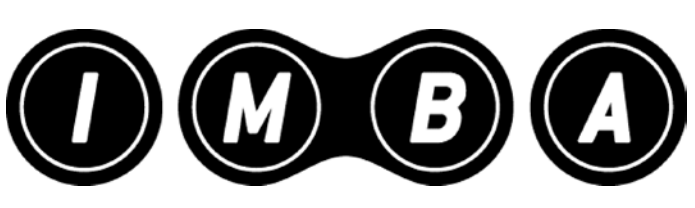


Gateway and Tunnel Trails

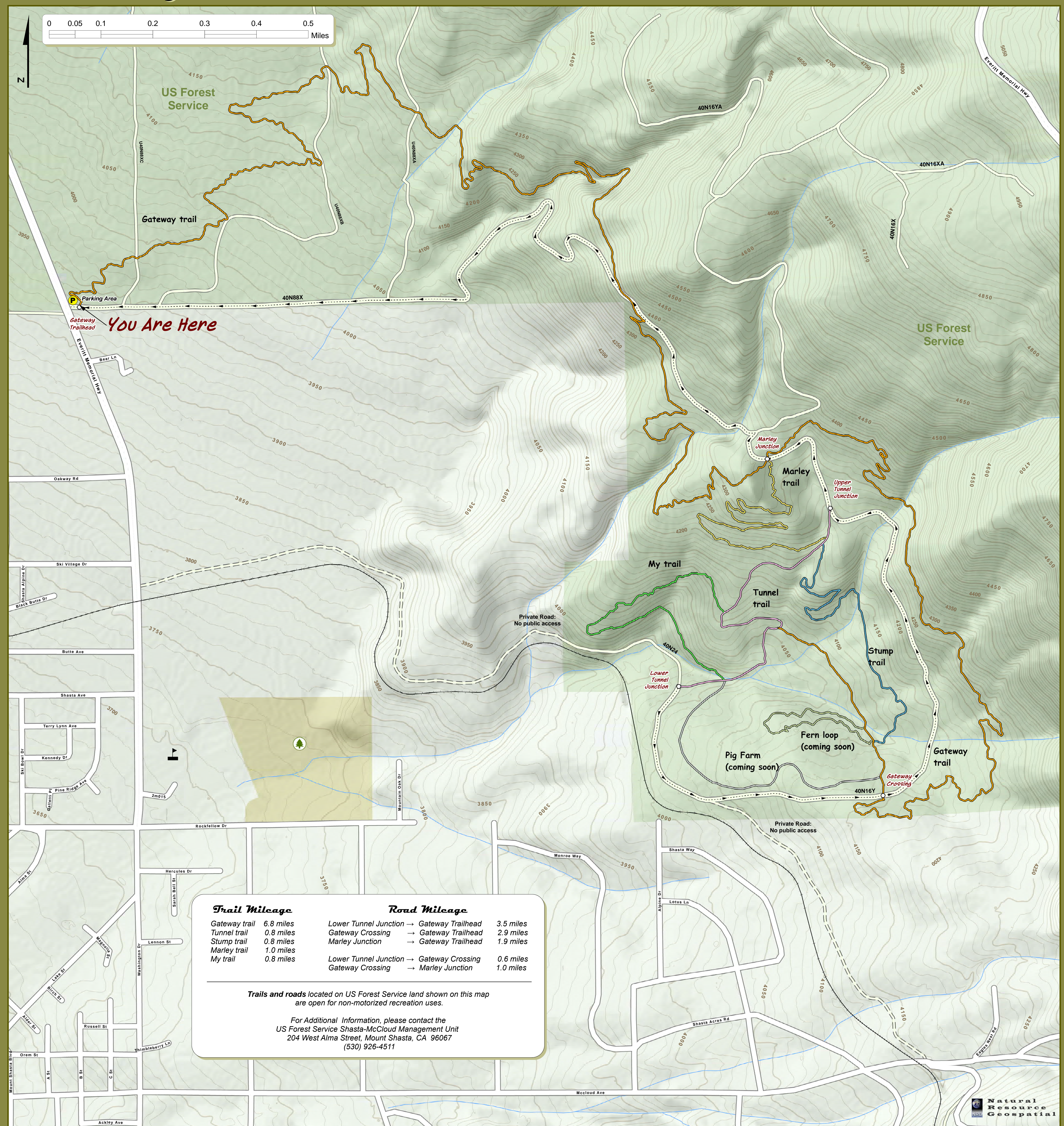

Marley trail	1.0 miles	Lower Tunnel Junction → Gateway Crossing	0.6 miles
